Sights to See Throughout the Florida Keys

The Florida Keys stretch about 126 miles from Key Largo (Mile Marker 126) to Key West (Mile Marker 0). Forty-two bridges connect the archipelago islands. There are many interesting points along the way. Just look for the green Mile Marker (MM) signs on the right side of the road. This list is mapped out as if you are driving from Miami heading south through the Florida Keys.

MM 110 – 89 Key Largo

John Pennekamp Coral Reef State Park – Snorkel and see the underwater statue of Christ. Located Oceanside – has main entrance. \$

Shell World – Local department store with unique gifts not found anywhere else. Located Oceanside at MM 97.5 – look for huge pink seashell.

MM 88– 66 Islamorada

Theater of the Sea – Explore the saltwater tanks which house sea rays, lobster, sharks, and other sea life. Also watch their dolphin show and learn about the Key's sea life. Located Oceanside at MM 84– has big sign. \$

MM 88 – Fine dining seafood restaurant for dinner. Located Oceanside at MM 88. \$

Island Silver and Spice – Local department store with a great selection of clothing for men, women and children. They also have a great selection of home accessories and gift items. Located Oceanside at MM 82, pink two story building.

Worldwide Sportsman – Shop for all of your deep-sea fishing tackle. They also have a great selection of Kahla shirts and Tommy Bahama clothing. Also visit their saltwater aquarium. Located Bayside, look for huge warehouse type building – has big sign.

Islamorada Seafood Company – Enjoy fresh local seafood in a beautiful outdoor setting right on the water. Located Bayside just after the Worldwide Sportsman. \$

Robbie's Marina – Hand feed tarpon that are up to 6 feet in length! Located Bayside on Lower Matecumbe Key MM 77– look for the Hungry Tarpon Restaurant and turn right. Robbie's Marina is located behind the restaurant. \$

MM 65 – 40 Marathon

Dolphin Research Center – Learn about these beautiful mammals and watch them perform. Located Bayside on Grassy Key – look for the huge mom and baby dolphin sculpture. \$

Crane Point Hammock – 64-acre tropical oasis of hardwood trees and nature trails. Located Bayside at MM 50.5. \$

Seven-Mile Bridge – Longest segmental bridge in the world.

- MM 39 Bahia Honda Key
Bahia Honda State Park – Historic location with beautiful natural beaches which often make the list of most beautiful beaches in America. Entrance is located Oceanside on Bahia Honda Key. \$
- MM 39 – 28 Big Pine Key
Key Deer – If you are driving, slow down and look out for the endangered Key Deer. You may see them grazing by the side of the highway. The largest Key Deer is about the same size of a large dog.
No Name Pub – It's hard to find but well worth the search. Eat their famous Royal Pub Pizza. Don't forget to decorate a dollar bill and staple it to the wall or ceiling – just about anywhere you like. Located Bayside, at light turn right, road forks so stay on right side. Go to stop sign, turn left at stop sign, follow road until you see pub on left side – look for it. \$
- MM 20 Upper Sugarloaf Key
Mangrove Mamas – Restaurant open for lunch and dinner. Old time Keys atmosphere. Entertainment on weekends. Located Bayside – look for sign.
- MM 17 Lower Sugarloaf Key
Bat Tower – Built to house bats that were brought from another location to eat the mosquitoes and other pesky flying bugs. The bats didn't like their new home and they all flew away. Bat Tower is still standing and unfortunately to this date there aren't any bats who will call it home! Located Bayside, turn left after Sugarloaf Motel, head down street towards Sugarloaf Airport, you can't miss the Bat Tower.
- MM 4-0 Any spot offers great viewing of the sunset.
Florida Keys Eco-Discovery Center – an exciting array of interactive exhibits highlighting the rich natural environment of the Keys. Located in NOAA's Dr. Nancy Foster Florida Keys Environmental Complex on the Truman Annex waterfront in Key West. \$
